## Classical, Contemporary and Modern Arabic Poetry

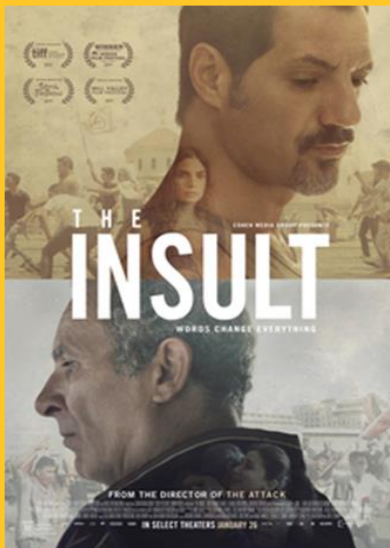
