

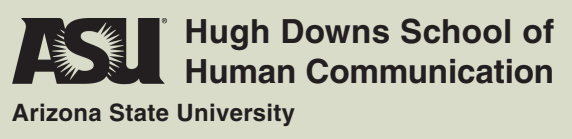
# Progress Not Perfection

And for those struggling with alcohol addiction, these conditions may have fostered a stronger urge to drink again. “Progress Not Perfection” is a performance inspired by “Beyond the Bottle,” a manuscript by Linda C. Lederman. Lederman’s creative non-fiction presents stories of recovery from people who want to stop drinking. The script by Tyler S. Rife provides a springboard for discussion about the lived experiences of people struggling with addiction in contexts of social isolation. You will meet characters—all in different stages in their journey to recovery—whose experiences with alcohol addiction, recovery, and progress are uniquely marked by this moment in time.
